Isolation & Quarantine Support Program

Offers one-time emergency rental/financial and utility assistance, grocery delivery, and hotel placement to qualifying residents of Santa Clara County.

*Only for those who test positive for COVID-19 or have been exposed to COVID-19 and meet all other eligibility requirements.
