In addition to referrals for openings at emergency shelters/ temporary housing programs, BWC's staff will help those seeking rental assistance by directing them to additional Homeless Prevention Services.

Please note the new hotline referral process is now built into HMIS. BWC will work with callers to complete their Release of Information (ROI) forms – in a way that is NOT a barrier to getting them screened for shelter placement.

If you are a case manager calling in with your client – we may ask for your assistance in helping clients sign the ROI.
